RESOLUTION #16-08-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOPLAND BAND OF POMO INDIANS SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE STANDING ROCK SIOUX TRIBE AND ALL THE MISSOURI RIVER TRIBES IN OPPOSITION OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE.

WHEREAS: the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians of the Hopland Reservation (here in hereafter referred to as "Tribe") is a federally-recognized Tribal Government exercising inherent sovereignty and jurisdiction over the Hopland Pomo Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has a duly elected Tribal Council that is the "Governing Body" who possesses the authority and power to enact all legislative documents on the Tribe's behalf; and

WHEREAS: the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians stands in solidarity with the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe, and other affected Missouri River tribes against the deplorable action of the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline, and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians Council does hereby urges President Obama, Congress and Bureau of Indian Affairs, to take any and all steps necessary to protect the environment and water resources of the Standing Rock Sioux and all other Missouri River Tribes

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians hereby requests of President Obama and Congress to immediately halt this project until such a time as a government-to-government consultation process can be fully implemented.
